Planting Advice for Park City Neighborhoods

Highland Estates alias "High Wind Estates"

A very windy area. Plant only the hardiest, wind-tolerant and cold-tolerant plants. Some suggestions are:

Siberian Pea Shrub

Canada Red Chokecherry or Schubert Chokecherry

Aspen

Spruces

Lilacs

Honeysuckle

Various drought tolerant shrubs

You need to create a wind break and then plant other plants within the boundaries. Amend your soil with gypsum and mulch. Add better topsoil.

Park Meadows

A fairly windy area and not very good soil. You can plant most of the trees and shrubs on the cold-hardy plant list. Avoid birch and use gypsum and mulch in the soil.

Thaynes Canyon

This area is a micro-climate. Almost everything grows there. Avoid some pine tree varieties because of all the porcupines that come down from the mountains nearby the area. Nice climate because of the homes and large trees.

Deer Valley

Hard, windy area. The same suggestions as the Highland Estates area.
