



**PARK CITY NURSERY'S**  
**HARDY LILACS**  
Blooms over 6500'

Lilacs require 2-3 years in the ground to establish and produce fruit of true size and color.

Bloom color and size will vary with soil nutrients. A healthy, well fertilized lilac will make longer, deeper hued blooms. Rose food is an excellent fertilizer for lilac- also, Fertilome "Blooming and Rooting" or just a well balanced 16-16-8 with iron.

Pruning: Lilacs should be pruned **AFTER** they bloom. They do not need to be pruned annually, just enough to control growth for shape and size and to stimulate more blossoms.

Lilacs are extremely drought and wind tolerant once established. Excellent hedge, or accent plant for elevation! Not to mention fragrance and cutting flower potential.

**Chinese Lilac- *Syringa chinensis-saugeana*** Zone 3

Vigorous, dense, upright lilac to 10' x 6'-8' wide. Rich lilac flowers in spring.  
Airy open clusters, non-suckering.

**Hybrid Lilac- *Syringa Hyacinthiflora*** Zone 2

Hybrid vulgaris and Chinese lilac to 10'-12' tall noted for extreme hardiness-  
bloom earlier than French hybrids could be a downfall at higher elevation!

Pocahontas - Purple

**Dwarf. Korean Lilac- *Syringa meyeri- 'Palibin'*** Zone 3

Dwarf lilac to 5'x5'-7' wide. Fragrant lilac to lavender flower, profuse at an early age.

**Hardy Lilac- *Syringa Prestoniae*** Zone 2

Deciduous shrub, 8"- 12' x same width. Extra hardy hybrid developed in Canada.  
Blooms about 2 weeks later than vulgaris and can tolerate more moisture.  
Semi-textured green leaf.

**Japanese Tree Lilac- *Syringa Reticulate*** Zone 4  
 Small tree or large shrub 20' x 15'. Extremely large, white flowers in early summer  
 Prefers some wind protection.

**Late Lilac- *Syringa villosa*** Zone 3  
 Deciduous shrub, 12' x 12' wide. Hardy late blooming lilac. Rosy, lilac bloom in late  
 spring, contrast with a textured green leaf.

**Miss Kim Lilac- *Syringa vilutina 'Miss Kim'*** Zone 4  
 Dwarf lilac to 3'. Small, lavender blossom in early summer, tolerates shade.

**Common Lilac- *Syringa vulgaris*** Zone 2  
 Deciduous shrub, 15'-20' x 15'-20' wide. Pink-lavender or white fragrant flowers  
 in spring contrast with smooth green leaf.

**French Lilac- *Syringa vulgaris (spp)*** Zone 2  
 Flowers a little later than common lilac. Large clusters of single or double showy  
 Flowers.
