



Lawn Watering Guide

Spring:

March/April:

- * Sprinklers need to be adjusted monthly due to water restrictions.
- * Allow snow to melt
- * Do not start watering
- * Mulch around tree wells and flower beds

May:

- * Wait until soil is completely dry before watering
- * Inspect sprinkler system for leaks and proper spray patterns
- * Water no more than twice a week. Proper watering will encourage healthy root development.

Summer

June:

- * Park City ordinance restricts watering to every other day. (due to change)
- * Park City ordinance restricts watering to between 7 pm & 10 am

July

- * Turn off water as it rains

August

- * At most water every other day. More is not better.

Fall:

September

- * Taper watering as days shorten and cooler weather prevails.
- * Water no more than every third day.

October

- * Aerate lawn and mulch around tree wells and flower beds.
- * Turn off water & blow out sprinkling systems
