High Altitude Roses

Most Hybrid tea roses cannot thrive through all of our winters. With special care they can survive but we've found they don't perform as well as they can in milder climates. They may do great for several season and then we'll have an unseasonably cold, dry fall or spring (no snow pack for insulation) and that does them in.
